Quilts of Valor

Friday, November 10, 2023, Turkey Hill Grange quilters proudly presented Quilts of Valor to 10 veterans. The near-capacity crowd in the Grange Dining Room celebrated the lives and accomplishments of veterans from World War II, Korea, Vietnam, and the Cold War era. Each veteran was recognized for their service as the quilters draped the quilt around their shoulders. Many of the veterans made brief statements about their service. Quilts of Valor Foundation registers each quilt ensuring it meets their size and design standards. The quilts have a label showing the veteran's name, dates of service, and the name of the quilter. The National Grange is a Quilts of Valor partner allowing Grange members to create quilts and award them to veterans. After the ceremony the veterans posed for pictures and enjoyed refreshments with their families, friends and Grange members.
